

# Leah Cowl

A simple pattern that makes a pretty, lacy cowl. If you knit this in chunky yarn like I did, you will have nearly instant gratification!

Materials: Yarn of your choice, Needles in a size to make it look nice, tapestry needle for weaving in ends. (White cowl knit in Cascade 128 superwash on size 11 needles,. 25 stitches. Teal cowl knit in Malabrigo Rios on size 9 needles, 37 stitches)

Cast on a multiple of 3 stitches, plus 4 for the Tidy Edges. For my Bulky yarn version I used 25 stitches.

Repeat pattern between \*'s until last two stitches.

Row 1: K2, \*K1, YO, K2Tog\*, slip 2 purlwise

Row 2: K2, \*P2, K1\*, slip 2 purlwise

Row 3: K2, \*K1, P1, K1\*, Slip 2 purlwise

Row 4: Repeat Row 2

Repeat these 4 rows until you have the length you want, then pick up the stitches at the cast-on end and graft the two ends together using Kitchner Stitch or graft of your choosing. Enjoy!
